Player of the Week

Harvard sophomore guard **NIKI FINELLI** [Ambler, Pa.] scored 46 points on the weekend to lead the Crimson to a sweep of Penn and Princeton and sole possession of first place in the League. Finelli was six-for-seven from beyond the arc and eight-for-eight from the charity stripe for a career-high 26 points against Penn. She pulled down five boards and collected three steals in the win. In Friday's win over Princeton, she had 20 points on eight-of-17 shooting from the floor, eight rebounds, three assists and two steals. Finelli is second on the team with 12.4 points per game.

Rookie of the Week

Brown freshman guard **CHRISTINA JOHNSON** [Oakland, Calif.] earned her first career start on Saturday and responded with 16 points in 38 minutes in the Bears' 57-54 victory over Columbia. Johnson was eight-for-14 from the field, grabbed four boards and had three steals. The night before, in a 68-59 loss to Cornell, Johnson had six points and four assists in just 17 minutes.

Ivy Honor Roll

Yale senior center **ERICA DAVIS** [Columbus, N.J.] was one block shy of the first triple-double in program history on Saturday night, finishing with 25 points, 13 rebounds and a school-record nine blocks in the Bulldogs' 61-45 win over Cornell. She averaged 22.5 points, 12.5 rebounds, three assists and six blocks per game over the weekend. In the loss to Columbia on Friday night, Davis had 20 points, 12 boards, three blocks and a career-high five assists. Davis has scored 20 points in four straight games, and is averaging 22.8 points and 12.8 rebounds during that span.

Columbia freshman center **CHELSEA FRAZIER** [Golden Valley, Minn.] continued to play well after recovering from an injury, averaging 13.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in two games this weekend. In Columbia's 72-64 win versus Yale, Frazier was an offensive force, hitting seven-of-12 shots from the field for 15 points in just 23 minutes. She was efficient on Saturday against Brown also, hitting four-of-seven from the field in addition to eight rebounds and a blocked shot.

Cornell sophomore forward **JEOMI MADUKA** [Arlington, Texas] averaged 13 points as the Big Red split contests with Brown and Yale. In a victory over the Bears, Maduka was nearly perfect, going five-for-five from the floor and seven-of-nine from the charity stripe for 17 points. She also grabbed eight rebounds, came up with three steals and blocked two shots. In Saturdays loss to the Bulldogs, Maduka scored nine points and grabbed a team-high eight rebounds. She shot 58.3 percent from the floor and was Cornell's second leading scorer both nights.

Brown senior guard **LENA McAFEE** [Reston, Va.] helped her Bears post their second Ivy League victory over Columbia on Saturday by scoring eight points and pulling down 10 rebounds. She went four-for-six from the field in the 57-54 win and dished out three assists and picked up one steal. In the Bears loss to Cornell the evening before, she was the team's second leading scorer with nine points, had seven rebounds, three assists and three steals.

Dartmouth senior guard **ASHLEY TAYLOR** [Cookeville, Tenn.] was golden in a weekend that pitted her against the other three of the League's top four scorers. She lived up to the challenge and was all over the court, averaging 20.5 points, 5.0 assists, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals in a pair of critical wins that pulled the Big Green into second place. Taylor shot 56.5 percent from the floor [including seven-of-10 three-pointers], but it was her defense that was central to the Big Green allowing just 89 points in the two games combined. Taylor proved herself head-to-head against her peers, personally holding Penn's Joey Rhoads to just four points while helping her team contain Monica Naltner to four and Princeton's Meagan Cowher to nine — all well below their season averages.

The Ivy League is producing a year-long online celebration of the 50th anniversary of formal Ivy League competition, featuring special articles every weekday through the end of May 2007. The celebration may be accessed at www.ivy50.com.

Although some League rivalries predate the Civil War, and the term "Ivy League" was used in newspapers as early as the mid-1930s, the Ivy League began formally with the Ivy Presidents' agreement of 1954, and the first year of formal competition was 1956-57.

Since the first Ivy contest, more than 75,000 Ivy athletes have played under a unique model of college sports, sharing a remarkably consistent goal: to provide successful athletics as an integral part of the full undergraduate experience – combining the values and lessons of athletics with those of the classroom and laboratory, the campus and the community – to produce leaders in every walk of life.

The 50th Celebration is not intended as a formal or complete history of each era, sport or school in the last half century. There's simply too much history to be able to do that – although the online Ivy League Record Book provides a wealth of information about Ivy League standings and All-Ivy teams, national successes in every sport, and individual athletic and academic achievements.

Rather, the Celebration will ask more than 200 former Ivy League athletes to tell the story of Ivy athletics through an almost-daily series of interview-based profiles. Combined with more comprehensive theme-based features (such as the Ivy League's long Olympic history), these profiles will cover every part of these 50 years at all eight schools – all of the more than 30 Ivy women's and men's championship sports (the broadest collegiate athletic participation in the country) – and the incredibly diverse backgrounds and careers of Ivy athletes.
